NOTES:

- 1 Bus apps – We have two companies/groups and you can use the same ticket on all the buses. *[I find it easiest to have both apps open when travelling with my granddaughter, as I can have her ticket on one and mine on the other – easier when getting onto the bus and validating your journey on the reader. You may find this useful, depending on how many phones you will have with you.]* You buy a bundle of five tickets at a time, each of which you activate on a day when you need to travel (do not have to be consecutive days). That ticket is then good for as many journeys within Cornwall as you need that day, on a hop-on-hop-off basis; just scan it at the reader by the driver, on entering each bus.



The apps are **First Bus in Cornwall**: you will need the First Bus app. It looks like this:  then set your travel region to 'Cornwall' and you will need the 'Cornwall Network' Pack of 5 x 1 Day tickets – Adult @£20.00



And **Go Cornwall Bus** which looks like this:  and you will need the Adult-5xDay-Cornwall @£20.00

You will be prompted to load your payment card when you request to purchase on the app.

This is all much easier than it sounds, when you're actually doing it!

- 2 Groupsave tickets give good discounts for small groups **who must remain together for the whole of the rail journey**. They are not valid for peak time travel, which is before 9.00 on weekdays. When you are buying you will be asked to select a journey time, but you can use them on any service which is off-peak. You do not need to book seats for any of our services out of holiday season.
- 3 Taxis – pre-book and if further numbers are required, please contact me. You don't need a directory of all taxi companies in this document!
- 4 The AZ South West Coast Path map book is your best option for all walks. I will purchase this locally and provide a separate directions summary too. **Please let me know if you are OK about me annotating the map book with pen/stickers to mark ...**
